#### 4. County / Borough Councillors' Reports.

**Cllr T Lawn :** Cllr Lawn was not present at this meeting and consequently no report was heard.

**Cllr WH Tindall :** Cllr Tindall reported that the issues identified in last years report regarding Glaisdale Rigg flooding and drainage problems have been scrutinised by NYCC Highways dept and site visits made by Cll Tindall and D Creek of NYCC. This has resulted in some work being done to alleviate the problems but much more is still needed.

The gritting of our local roads (especially Fryup areas) is still a matter for some concern and despite assurances from NYCC that the work is getting done there is little evidence on the ground. Potholes and edge repair work is still ongoing, but needs to be given higher priority and pressure needs to be maintained on NYCC to complete these works.

Cllr Tindall ended his report by thanking Councillors for their support over the past year.
