MINUTES OF GLAISDALE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held at The Robinson Institute, Glaisdale, on Thursday 21st July 2011.

1. **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING** were presented, agreed and signed as a true record.

2. **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

2.1 Police attendance and report.

- Incidents of note in Glaisdale Parish :
 - 28/06/11 - B Transport Police, assisted by NY Police officers, arrested 2 males at Glaisdale Rail Station on Drunk & Disorderly charge.
- Other incidents in wider local area :
 - Black Mercedes Car broken into near St Heddas Church at Egton Bridge. Numerous items stolen from the vehicle (Mobile phone, credit cards, cash, driving license and insurance documents. etc.) Enq's continue.
- Other Information :
 - Local Rural Officers will be rolling out a new scheme throughout the area soon called "Nominated Neighbour". This scheme is very simple and designed to assist the Vulnerable, Elderly and Isolated residents in the area who may be viewed as easy targets by criminals and cold calling sales persons. In simple terms the idea is that residents in the community who feel vulnerable can nominate a neighbour/ local trusted person to assist on their behalf should suspicious persons call at their homes. This is achieved by handing a pre-printed card (through the letterbox or chained door) to the caller which politely explains they are not known to them and if they require access they should contact the nominated neighbour details pre-written on the card). Should the caller be genuine (such as a service engineer needing to inform residents of shutdown etc in emergency repairs) they will be able to contact the neighbour who can escort them. The scheme is in response to recent bogus callers using the water board tactic in the Ripon area, subsequently gaining entry and committing burglary.

The request did not make clear what type of assistance was being requested, be it financial or physical, and members asked the Clerk to write requesting clarification and also further details as to what alternatives have been considered. Suggestion was also made that the PCC should approach Bramalls - the contractors working on the housing development at Glaisdale, to see what assistance may be available through their community engagement ideals which are being exercised at present.**
- 4.4 ** Request for financial support - Glaisdale Tennis Club.
- **Request received for financial support from Glaisdale Tennis Club. The club has decided that in order to improve the usage of the court at Glaisdale membership requirements should be abolished and access given freely to all who wish to play. The costs of maintenance etc. would still need to be met and the club is seeking support from the wider community. Members agreed that this strategy should be supported and free use of the facility encouraged. Proposal to make small contribution made by Cllr MF, seconded Cllr PT, all members in agreement. Cheque 100745 issued in payment.**
