MINUTES OF GLAISDALE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held at The Robinson Institute, Glaisdale, on Thursday 18th July 2019.

Councillors were pleased to welcome both candidates for the vacant position of Parish Councillor to represent the Lealholm Ward. The candidates were given opportunity to ask questions of members and for members to reciprocate and to learn more from each candidate.

Candidates were requested to withdraw from the meeting while members considered which candidate the position should be offered to. The decision was not unanimous and after a show of hands members decided, by three votes to two, to offer the position to Mr Mark Hollingworth.

Mr Stringer was thanked for his interest and assured that members would be happy to consider him again should any future vacancy arise.

Mark Hollingworth was taken through the declaration process and requested to complete a Register of Interest form to be returned within 28days. Mark was then declared duly appointed and welcomed onto the council by all present.

- 5.1.1 Houlsyke village green car parking issues. Signage requirements?
- Members advised of email received from Houlsyke parishioner complaining that the access space in the centre of Houlsyke (nominally ‘the green’) is being overrun by vehicles using it as a car park. Members are aware of this issue and some years ago there was a ‘no parking’ sign erected on the green to try and alleviate the problem. The ‘green’ is owned by the parish council and so is not common land nor is it open access

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land. There are a number of properties fronting onto the green, most of which have requirements to park a vehicle(s), and in recognition of the fact that there is no other alternative parking available in Houlsyke, the council decided some time ago to allow reasonable parking on this space for property owners with access requirements.

- The parish council does not intend to ban all parking on the green as long as that parking does not restrict the access rights of those properties fronting the green. Clerk to inform the resident who initiated the complaint accordingly.

7. MATTERS OF INTEREST RAISED BY MEMBERS

- 7.1 NYCC Highways issues.
- Roadside drains at Butterwits Lane and at Hollins Lane Houlsyke require cleaning out prior to excessive rainfall which has caused flooding in the past.
 - Culvert fencing at foot of Woodocks bank Glaisdale and at Oakley Walls Lealholm remains damaged and is still awaiting repair. NYCC to be urged to complete this work asap.

- Cllr Featherstone informed members that the Open Gardens event this year raised approx. £4200.00. 50% of this was donated to the Air Ambulance Services and the remainder to local community causes.
