## 5. CORRESPONDENCE

### 5.1 Action / Reply

- 5.1.1 Unsafe fencing at Mitre Cottage Glaisdale – ongoing enquiry as to ownership/responsibility.
- Members informed of enquiries so far made as to ownership of wooden fencing situated on top of the boundary wall to the highway at junction of C56 and 38R roads in Glaisdale (In front of Mitre Cottages). The ownership of the fence is not known and there are several complicating factors.
    - o The fence is attached to the top of the boundary wall to the highway and some 10 feet above the highway surface.
    - o The boundary wall ownership has not been identified. GPC has in the past discussed this matter with NYCC (who we believe are the logical owners) but they have denied ownership as it does not appear on any of their Asset Registers.
    - o The land on the top of the wall is designated common land which comes under the jurisdiction of the Danby Court Leet.(DCL)
    - o Between the fence itself and the Mitre Cottages is a designated RoW (Bridleway) and while bridleways are administered by NYMNPA they are maintained by NYCC.
  - Enquiries have started with DCL, they being most likely to have any records to identify when, by whom, and on whose instruction the wall, on which the fence sits, was built. This information is yet to be forthcoming from DCL and further communication will be held with NYCC to try and resolve this situation asap.
